For more than a quarter of a century we have been carrying fish, meat, fruit, vegetables, flowers and other products for which correct and stable temperatures are essential. Today, 75% of our business is international, and our company is still growing.

Large capacity

The Stie's fleet currently numbers more than 120 thermo-vehicles, each with a capacity of up to 22 tons, depending on the product carried. More than 14,000 tons of farmed fish were sold in 1982, Stie's transporting a substantial portion.

Modern vehicle fleet

With their smart blue-and-white livery Stie's road-trains are a familiar sight on the main roads of Europe. In the course of one year they travel the equivalent of 350 times the distance round the Equator. That's 200 million ton-kilometres!

The Stie's fleet is of a very high standard. All vehicles have an average service life of about two years. Repairs and maintenance are carried out at our own service centre in Oslo.

Purpose-built for fresh fish

Our vehicles are built to carry standard EUR pallets and to ensure that cargoes stand firm without rocking, thus reducing damage to a minimum. Temperatures are thermostatically sustained at preset levels throughout the journey.
